





MINISTRY CENTER TAKES SHAPE

Over 5 years ago, God called us to move to Mexico, and we began praying about the ministry. We were given a vision to build a ministry center that we could use for training workshops and conferences, as well as allow the different Christian groups to use for their own retreats and other Christian events. After the move, and we found ourselves living on a big piece of dirt, with all of the difficulties of having no water, no electricity, and no space. There were times when it was hard to remember the vision of the actual physical Ministry Center. Praise God that in only 2 years, stage one of the ministry center is unfolding before our eyes! When this building is finished, we will have a meeting room large enough to hold 100 people, a kitchen off one end (we will have to move Dwight's shop out) as well as public rest rooms! How exciting it is to see God's plan unveiled before us!

WORK PARTIES GALORE!

One of the uses of our new room will be work parties where we can get some people in and "spread out" to collate materials and get books made!

SPACE!!!

Currently, our office and work space is pretty cramped, which can be good, but creates problems as well. When we are not having meetings, we will be able to move equipment out of our office and create work areas around each piece. The thought of not being so cramped is really exciting!

NEW VBS COMPLETE!


We are now finished writing and designing the new 2007 VBS material! It's our best program yet! Evangelism focused and race-car themed, this program includes kids workbooks, teachers books, director's pack, posters (one pictured left), and a CD with music and racing sound effects. We were able to write and record one new song, special for the VBS, as well as a really cool audio introduction (thanks to Rubén joining the team.) The children will be taking a 'pitstop' from their normal lives to check their spiritual condition, making sure they are ready to hit the road again in top condition, and run the race that God has set before them. MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES ABOUND

We have been blessed with a great opportunity! On April 12th, the Church of God (southern northwest territory) is having their annual convention where they gather from Sonora, Sinaloa, and the Baja. They have invited us to do a workshop, and we are pleased to be able to give each church the VBS, including a workbook for each child. Please pray for us now thru April 12th, since these weeks we will be printing and packaging kits for each of 126 churches, which will be reaching 7,539 kids!

We are pleased to announce the new members of the Pro-Visión indoor staff team, Rubén and Toñita. Rubén is part of a local Christian band, and has added his skills of recording and music to our projects. He does editing and Spanish corrections, has learned the risograph and collator, as well as helps us attend to the local pastors when they arrive, taking their orders and filling them. Toñita has come on board as a primary helper for Kristi including office work as well as cleaning the house and office. She has dived in to learn how to run the collator and bookmaker and does a great job of cranking out thousands of books. As a side-perk in their new jobs with us, they got to pose as "super teacher" models for a conference poster that will make them famous throughout 3 states of Mexico (See cover)!



6000 CARS
