We are currently in the middle of a tour getting children's material out to 8 cities, and we are about 2/3 done. The material we are giving out is a VBS and 6 months of Sunday School curriculum. (plus a camp and other misc. items) We are really stretched right now in every conceivable way. Basically, we are way in over our heads! But thanks to God we keep getting through!


We had originally expected to get the VBS to 17,000 kids this summer. Looks more like 24,000 right now.

The biggest weekend of the tour, we left for Hermosillo with the van and a trailer overloaded with over 100 boxes of materials. (I figure the paper and Riso ink for just that weekend cost well over \$3k). We brought back a little, but not much.


One Monday, we sat down and figured out what we had to produce that week. I almost cried. I started praying (and whining) saying "there is no way on Earth we are going to get this done!" Then, I felt God speak to me, "You are not doing an 'earthly' project!" Soon after, the Riso broke down, money came in, we bought enough paper, and we got it all done! (I still have no idea how) I go through a similar thing each week except I am learning to keep the whining to a minimum.

God has come through for us time and time again with visitors who pitch-in and make booklets, money that shows up at exactly the right time, encouragement just when needed... equipment that keeps working and (Divine) inspiration how to get it working when it doesn't! I am getting to where I expect a miracle. (I know God doesn't have to, but He does over and over) We missed our last newsletter because we had no time, so we have not really been able to get the word out about what is going on.

We love our Pro-Vision team (y'all) and really appreciate the prayer, moral and financial support!

They were a real blessing helping produce material and getting us organized. Christopher built a great workbench and organized the shop, Diane organized our accounting, and Philip and Kate made us a training video to go along with the new VBS. Later in May Mike Kangas came down bringing 34 tubes of ink and other supplies we needed for the tour.

We are excited about giving away this curriculum for free to all those interested and can make it to a seminar! It's so difficult to find spanish material down here, and it is all very expensive. Thanks to the whole Pro-Vision team, we are able to do this for free to anyone who will use it! This is really important because most of the churches do not have the resources to purchase it. We are definitely overtaxing our existing Risograph printer, but help is on the way. We purchased a nice used printing press and with the help of Mike Kangas and Net Works Ministries, it is here and almost ready to go into production!

We had a great time in Caborca hooking-up with a team from Branches Church of Scappoose. Also, our previously reported van problems were solved by a van from Net Works. Thanks guys!


We invited our little sister Suki Kangas down to help us with the whole tour and she has been a 'super' help these past 2 months
